REPORT CARD PROCESS

Dear Parents and Caregivers:

We are writing to share that the report cards you will receive this year will reflect the Ministry of Education and Child Care reporting order that underwent change last year. The Greater Victoria School District has been preparing for these changes and you will likely notice a slight difference from the previous year.

Some highlights from the Ministry include:

- The use of the Provincial Proficiency Scale from K-9 and letter grades and percentages in grades 10-12
- Descriptive feedback on all report cards from K-12
- Student self-reflection of Core Competencies and goal setting
- Graduation status update for students in grade 10-12 in June

As a district, one change we have made last year is the way you will receive your child's report card. **Families will access report cards via SD61's Parent Connect on Friday, December 20**. Parent Connect is what you may have already used to give your child online permissions (i.e.: Neighbourhood walks, computer use, etc). Please <u>click here</u> to go to Parent Connect.

How do I let the school know my child will be absent from school?

If your child will be absent from school, please let the school know. You can either **email braefoot@sd61.bc.ca** or call the **attendance line at 250-477-6948** and leave a message. Please tell us the student's full name, division/teacher, reason for the absence (ex. sick, vacation, appointment) and how long the student will be away.

You are welcome to email your child's teacher as well, but it is important to let the office know as we update the student attendance system. If a child is absent and the office has not been notified by a parent, an email and/or phone call will be sent to parents.

Students who arrive late to school, or who are picked up during the day, must sign in on the clipboard on the table outside the office.

Preparing for Grade 5 Transition to Middle School

- If you have a student in Grade 5 at Braefoot, could you please ensure the school office has your most up-to-date address.
- If your address has changed since you signed the student verification form in September, please notify the school of your new address, and provide the required supporting documents.
- Grade 5 students do not "automatically" follow a pathway, and they will be registered at their catchment school according to the address currently on file at the school.



Grade 5 families will receive a letter in January which includes the catchment middle school their child will be registered at and information on the option to apply for a transfer.

Project Notification



Braefoot Neighbourhood Bikeway & Traffic Calming Upgrades

December 2024

What's happening?

The District of Saanich is implementing a Neighbourhood Bikeway on Braefoot Road between Cedar Hill Cross Road and Mckenzie Ave.

The project is proposed to include signage, pavement markings, and traffic calming to reduce speeds and make Braefoot Rd. more comfortable to cycle on for people of all ages and abilities.

Why are we doing this?

Neighbourhood Bikeway:

Part of Saanich's Active Transportation Plan is to build off of existing infrastructure to enhance the connectivity of Saanich's bicycle network. With recently installed protected bike lanes on Mckenzie Ave, and coming upgrades to bicycle infrastructure on Cedar Hill Cross Road, creating a neighbourhood bikeway along Braefoot Road will create a bicycle friendly connection between these two routes.

Neighbourhood Bikeways are streets with lower volumes and speeds and typically include signage, roadway markings, and traffic calming to prioritize bicycle traffic.

Speed Limit Reduction and Traffic Calming Upgrades:

The maximum speed limit on a Neighbourhood Bikeway should be no more than 30km/h. Therefore, the speed limit on Braefoot should be reduced to 30km/h and the vellow centre-line removed to better accommodate parking on both sides.

In addition, speed humps are typically installed and up to 5 are proposed along Braefoot Rd to act as a traffic calming measure.

Parking Changes:

Updated parking restrictions will be installed in certain locations such as near the park, school and intersections. These changes are to ensure there is adequate space for large vehicles such as those used by emergency services, garbage or recycling collection trucks to maneuver the street and ensure sightlines are achieved.
